

For the Tecolote Shores Park project, it was necessary to ensure that the new structure blended well with the existing playground. To achieve this, we used the colors found on the playground in the custom laser cut panels. This shelter allows for a shady place to hang out while also giving a distinctive shadow on the ground below. The outcome was a visually cohesive structure that blended in seamlessly with the playground's surroundings.

River Park at SDSU Mission Valley, designed by Schmidt Design Group in San Diego, CA, is a vibrant public open space that reconnects the community to the San Diego River through trails, recreation areas, and gathering spaces. A standout feature of the park is a sculptural shelter composed of over 400 Alaskan Yellow Cedar wood slats installed on both the top and underside of the structure. As sunlight filters through the slats, it creates a dynamic “river” of light and shadow below, evoking the movement of water and reinforcing the park’s connection to its natural setting.



Avance by D.R. Horton is a gated residential community in Phoenix, AZ at the base of South Mountain that blends modern homes with scenic views and easy access to nature. The neighborhood is designed to connect residents with outdoor recreation. Within the development itself, homeowners enjoy shared industrial shelters with I-beam frame members, unique overhangs, and bench swings that create a usable community green space and support outdoor living.

The Rotary Grove picnic area at Elk Grove Regional Park has been revitalized with a new steel shade shelter, replacing an aging wooden structure through a collaboration between the Cosumnes Community Services District and the Rotary Club of Elk Grove. The cantilevered steel shade structures are designed with perimeter posts to keep views open to the center and feature laser-cut panels that create “dappled shade, reminiscent of the original structure that was here,” while ensuring long-term durability. The upgraded space blends function, safety, and symbolism, serving as a lasting community gathering place that reflects Rotary’s commitment to service, unity, and sustainability.



By anchoring community wellness and downtown life, the park transforms underused urban landscape into a dynamic public destination that enhances quality of life and civic pride.

Garrison Garden Paseo is a newly opened linear park in Arvada, Colorado that transforms a previously steep and uninviting corridor between 57th Avenue and Ralston Road into an accessible, landscaped pedestrian and bike path. It serves as a key community connector, linking local neighborhoods with transit, trails, parks, shops, and dining, while featuring terraced walkways, demonstration gardens, and scenic overlooks with mountain views. The key feature of the park being a custom “honeycomb” structure with powder-coated laser cut panels and round columns to blend into the surroundings. The design celebrates placemaking by incorporating natural water features and collaborative garden spaces that enhance both recreation and neighborhood interaction.

ICON Shelter Systems, Inc. warrants to the original purchaser that its products will be free from manufacturing defects, structurally sound, and capable of being assembled using standard tools and construction practices.

This warranty applies only when structures are properly maintained, used solely for their intended purpose, and have not been modified, altered, or repaired without written approval from an authorized ICON Shelter Systems representative, where such changes may affect the condition or operation of the product.

The structural limited warranty is valid for fifteen (15) years, powder coat for ten (10) years, and coastal powder coat for five (5) years from the date of invoice. This warranty is subject to the following terms and conditions:

This warranty is in effect only if the structure has been assembled and installed strictly in accordance with ICON installation drawings and good construction practices and has been subjected only to normal use and exposure.

This warranty is valid only if the structures are maintained according to proper maintenance procedures; have been subjected to only normal use for the purpose for which the goods were designed; have not been subjected to addition or substitution of parts; and have not

been modified, altered, or repaired without the approval of an Icon Shelter Systems' approved representative in any respect which, in the judgment of Icon Shelter Systems, affects the condition or operation of the structures.

The owner shall notify ICON to arrange for an inspection within thirty (30) days after discovery of any defect under this warranty, and before any alteration or repair is made or attempted.

ICON is in no way responsible for damages caused by others, including vandalism, fire, lightning, or acts of God, corrosion caused by moisture, chemicals, air or salt spray, pollution, or infestation by rodents or other vermin.

Accounts that have been authorized have a 30-day net payment period.


